

# Dialog® Profile QRC

A Dialog Profile allows you to store SET commands for automatic execution each time you log on. SET commands allow you to modify different aspects of your search session. For a complete list of the SET commands, use the HELP SET command. A Profile is unique to the userid on which it is created.

<p><b>Create a New Profile</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>BEGIN</b> in a free file. (Free files include Chronolog® (410), Bluesheets (415), and any of the ONTAP® files.)</li> <li>Type the command <b>EDIT</b> to enter the editor.</li> <li>Enter the <b>SET</b> commands you want to use. To switch to connect-time mode, type the command: <b>SET CONNECT ON</b>. <p><b>Review Your Profile</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enter <b>RECALL PROFILE</b>. This will show you the SET commands. The "SET CONNECT ON" line indicates that you have turned the Connect-Time mode on.</li> </ol>	<pre>?recall profile Line Command ----- 1. SET CONNECT ON 2. SET HI ON</pre>
<p><b>Edit Your Profile</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enter <b>EDIT PROFILE</b> to begin editing your profile.</li> <li>Enter the letter <b>L</b> (for list), which will show you the lines in your profile. Make note of the line number you wish to edit; Line 10 in this example.</li> <li>Use the <b>CHANGE</b> command. The format is: <b>C &lt;line #&gt;/old text/new text</b> Ex., c 10/on/off for line 10, to change the text "on" to "off"</li> <li>Enter <b>L</b> again to review the change.</li> <li>When finished making changes, enter <b>SAVE PROFILE</b>.</li> <li>Enter <b>Y</b> to replace your old profile. (If you want to abandon the changes, enter N.)</li> </ol> <p><i>Hint: If you only have one SET Command in your profile, it is easier to create a new one.</i></p>	<pre>?edit profile Editor entered Name: PROFILE Total lines: 2 Line increment: 10 Last line: 20 EDIT: ?l 10.
