Dialog's Domain Names database provides comprehensive look-up services for Internet domain names. The file contains over 90 million domain name records. In DialogWeb, you're guided through your search to find exactly the domain name information you need.

**Step 1.** Use the "Browse" function to search Domain Name Information from the drop-down list.

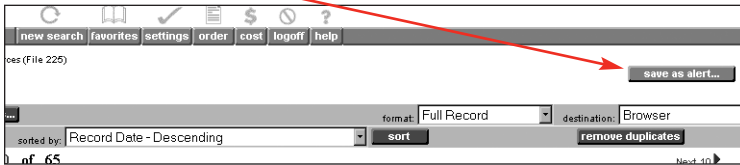
**Step 2.** Enter your search term ("sneaker" in this example) and click BROWSE to view a list of results.
